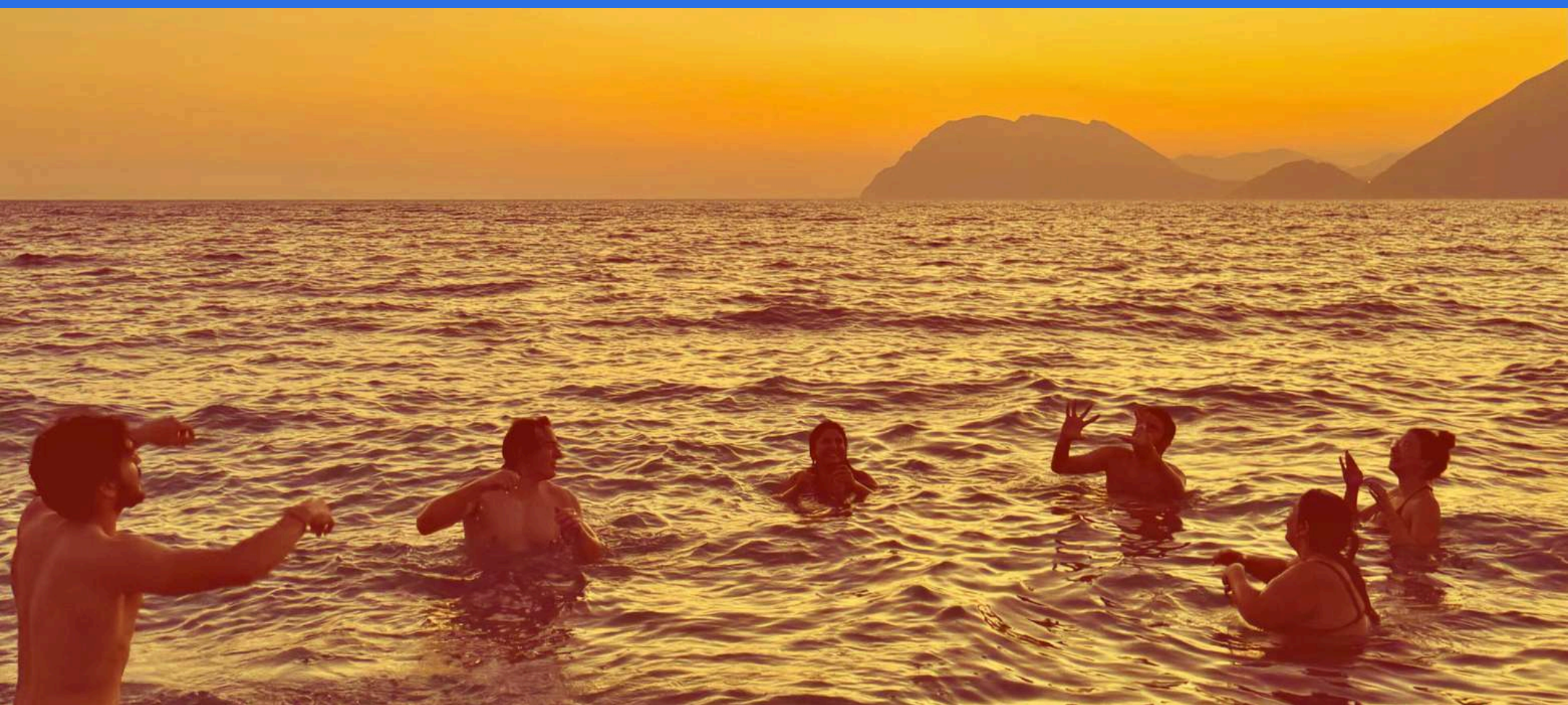

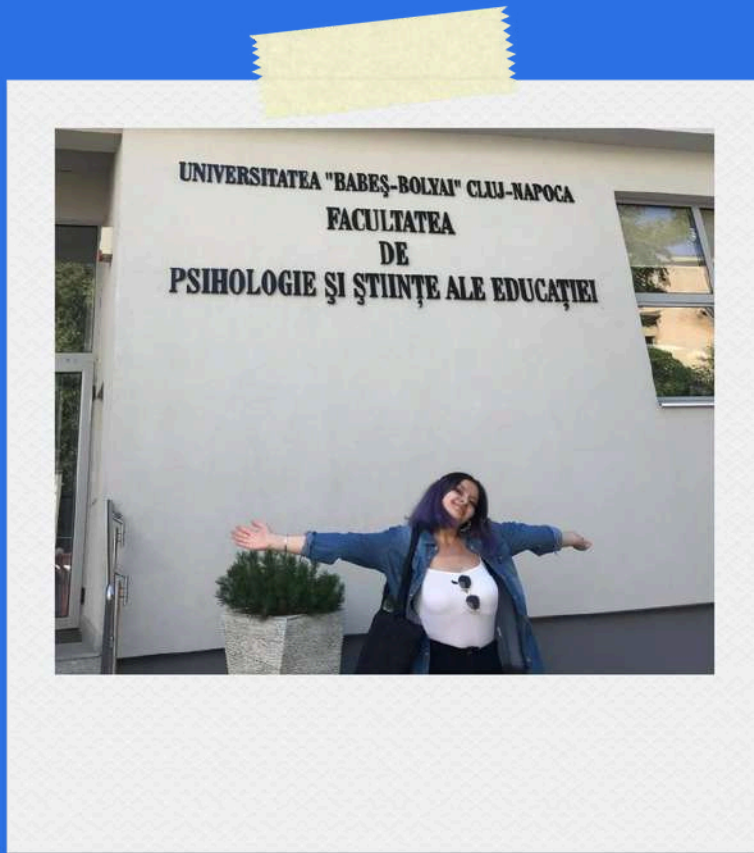
I developed myself not only culturally but also academically. I had the chance to observe Europe's education system closely and expanded my knowledge by taking courses in my field and other areas.

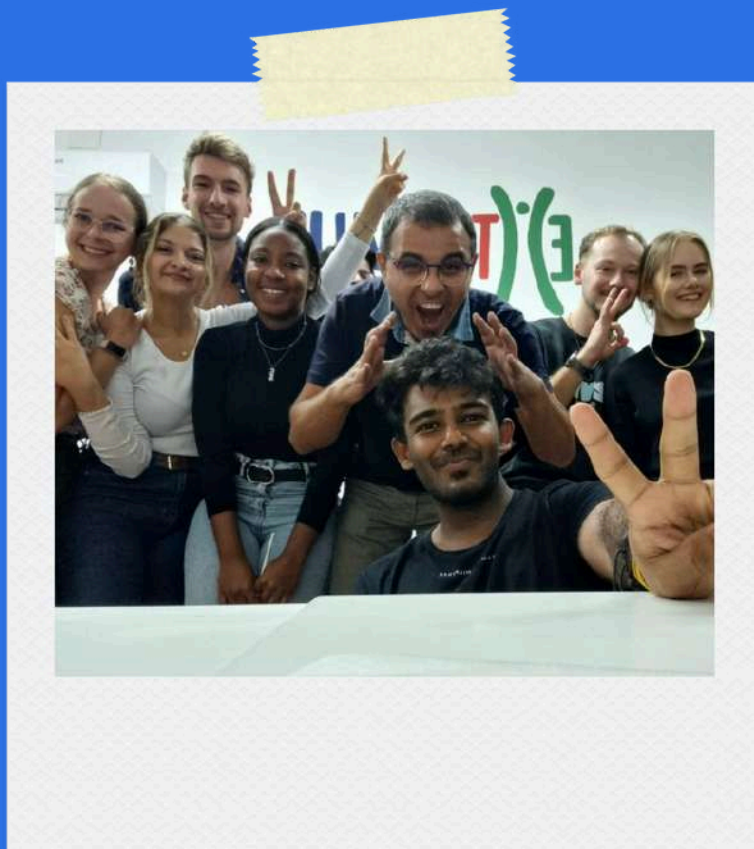
# naz, gpc, alumni
