



SCHOOL FACILITIES



Dormitory (on-campus housing)

- Single room(very small number of vacancies), double room, quad room are available.
- International students can choose 5 days meal(per week) option, 7 days meal options or no meal option.
- In dormitory cafeteria, only Korean food will be served (lots of pork and spicy food, no halal food).
- Kitchen for international students is available (need to pay 10,000KRW for deposit and access card)
- Students have to change dormitory room for every semester and every vacation (4 times a year).
- Students staying in dormitory must submit TB test result for every semester and vacation (4 times)
- Each room, we have bed, desk, chair, closet
- dormitory fee (from September 1st till December 17th, 2017)

• A Book café is centrally located on campus and offers hot and cold beverages and snacks at a reasonable price.

Bank

• There is a bank (Nonghyup Bank) located on campus. You can open your bank account, exchange currency and transfer currency domestically and overseas at this bank.

Convenience Store

• You can purchase daily supplies at one of several convenience stores on campus. Convenience stores are also located in several dormitories.

Sports facilities

• Gym, Tennis courts, Ping Pong, Soccer/Football stadium, Futsal stadium, Golf club are all located on campus. Use of some facilities, such as the golf club, require fees.

Free Korean language class

- We open free Korean language classes for all international students.
- Class will start with basic Korean alphabet (hangul ¬, ∟, ⊏, ⊇).
- This is non-credit course.

Korean buddy program

• We will match one international student and one Korean student. These students will help you to settle yourself in Korea by helping to provide answers to basic questions you may have.

Voluntary Activity

- You can visit local elementary school, middle school or high school to introduce your own country.
- You will receive certificate for this voluntary activity and small amount of allowance as a reward.

PART-TIME WORK



Part-time work for international students

- International students who hold D-2 Visa can have opportunity to do part-time work in Korea during one's study period.
- According to Korean immigration rules and regulations, all international students must report one's parttime work to local immigration office.
- Allowed working hours: Maximum 30 hours per week during semester. Unlimited working hours only during vacation.
- Allowed working places and categories: Translation, serving at restaurant or coffee shops, simple office work assistant (Any kind of teaching, teaching assistant or lecturing activity is strictly prohibited)

Rules regarding part-time work

- Final approval of your work will be made by the officer of immigration office. If you violate part-time work regulation,
- Found your violation first time: you cannot do part time work for one year
- Found your violation second time: you cannot do part time work for good
- Found your violation third time: your study permit will be canceled for good
