

1/3-Scholarships for “Emerging Markets” General Management MBA: Your Kick-Off to a Career in Management

On **November 8th, 2019** the postgraduate master program General Management MBA will start for the 20th time. This successful MBA program is jointly conducted by the TU Wien in cooperation with the Danube University Krems. The FIBAA-accredited program offers prospective managers the opportunity to acquire basic economic, legal and social skills.

A central concern of both universities is to enable qualified junior managers from so called “emerging markets” to take part in continuing education programs. They therefore offer special scholarships to enable prospective managers to further their academic education, perfect their knowledge of the respective foreign language and at the same time acquire intercultural competence. By supporting postgraduate students from “emerging markets”, the TU Wien and the Danube University Krems contribute to the education of excellently trained managers from Eastern and South-Eastern Europe.

Partial Scholarship

A partial scholarships amounting to one third of the course fee of EUR 7,300 will be awarded to alumni of technical, technical-economical or natural science studies. Admitted individuals from Eastern or South-Eastern European countries must hold an academic degree along with a minimum of two years’ work experience and adequate knowledge of the English and German language. The remaining program fee amounts to EUR 14.600.

Application Requirements

- High motivation for the participation in the General Management MBA
- Financial need (private financing of the MBA program)
- Successful completion of the admission process
